➤ **CHAIR ACTIVITIES**

- Attended the BOD meeting, Tuesday, August 4, 2020.
- Met with the CRCXXXIII Executive Committee, Wednesday, August 12, 2020.
 - Topic of discussions:
 - Considering these difficult and challenging circumstances a recommendation was made by the Chair to cancel the CRCXXXIII Convention scheduled for January 7th – 10th, 2021 at the Hyatt Regency McCormick Place. There is still an increasingly amount of COVID19 transmissions, and the health and safety of the fellowship must remain our top priority. All EC members agreed.
 - Discussed optional contingency plan for hosting a virtual convention. Discussion was tabled to place as an item on the agenda for the CRCXXXIII Convention Committee to way pros and cons and vote.
- Preceded over the CRCXXXIII Convention Committee meeting, Sunday, August 16, 2020
 - Topic of discussion:
 - Contingency plan for hosting a 1 Day virtual convention.
 - After presentation was provided by members of EC, Q&A, pros & cons the committee voted to not have a virtual convention.
